Emory University employees and students on Emory-sponsored international travel now have access to emotional support services and emergency medical insurance through the university's International SOS membership. Emotional support services assist students, faculty, and staff in dealing with any psychological issues for which short-term counseling is appropriate while abroad. The travel health insurance provides international emergency medical coverage; it is supplemental, and travelers should maintain their primary policy.
