Travel Medical

Medical Expense Benefit: \$500,000

Dental (injury only/alleviation of pain): \$1,000/\$1,000

AD&D

Accidental Death & Dismemberment: \$10,000, \$1,000,000 aggregate per any one loss

Medical Evacuation and Repatriation

- Medical Evacuation: 100% of Covered Expenses
- Repatriation of Mortal Remains: 100% of Covered Expenses
- · Return of Dependent Children: Included in evacuation benefit, if insured is evacuated

Ouarantine Benefit

 Lodging and meals, one-way airfare ticket to either home country or rejoin trip, non-refundable travel arrangements: \$2,000 if required by government

Emergency Reunion Benefit

Emergency Reunion Benefit: \$10,000, daily benefit not to exceed \$300, max of 10 days
if hospitalized for at least 24 hours or victim of felonious assault, if victim of felonious assault then the travel
must occure within 24 hours of the occurrence or hospitalization

Security Evacuation

- Security Evacuation: \$100,000
- Aggregate Benefit for any one occurrence: \$1,000,000
